- to accept the book you have to accept it's supernatural


- The book is written in multiple languages so it must be written by more than one guy
- Jesus steps into the debate: Case Closed!



Siege of Jerusalem #1

- Jerusalem Falls
- The Temples is ransacked

Hostages are taken:

- Four teenage boys are taken
- Daniel and three of his friends
- Begins the 70-year "Servitude Of The Nation"
 - 2 Chronicles 3

Siege of Jerusalem #2

- · Jehoiakim listens to the false prophets and riots
- · Jeremiah and Ezekiel say don't do it!
 - "yield to the will of God"
- Jehoiakim ignores Jeremiah and rebels anyway
 - He is killed Jeremi - His son Jeconiah is named king
 - This soft becoman is named king
- Jeconiah is captured + 10,000 captives
 - including Ezekiel

- Ezekiel 1:1-3; 2 Kings 24:8-20; 2 Chronicles 36:6-10

Zedekiah, his uncle, is named king

Siege of Jerusalem #3

Jeremiah and Ezekiel warn him NOT to rebel

- Jeremiah and Ezekiel say don't do it!
 - Zedekiah listens to the false prophets
 - "Nebuchadnezzar is an instrument of God's judgment"
- 587 BC Zedekiah ignores Jeremiah and Ezekiel
 Jeremiah 32:5: 39:6-7: Ezekiel 12:13: 2 Kings 25:1-7
- 587 BC Nebuchadnezzar destroys Jerusalem
 Burns the Temple to the ground
