Daniel 9:1-3

In the first year of Darius son of Xerxes (a Mede by descent), who was made ruler over the Babylonian kingdom —

in the first year of his reign, I, Daniel, understood from the Scriptures, according to the word of the LORD given to Jeremiah the prophet, that the desolation of Jerusalem would last seventy years.

So I turned to the LORD God and pleaded with Him in prayer and petition, in fasting, and in sackcloth and ashes.

Jeremiah 25:11-12

This whole land will become a desolate wasteland. Israel and her neighboring lands will serve the king of Babylon for seventy years.

Then, after the seventy years of captivity are over, I will punish the king of Babylon and his people for their sins," says the LORD.

The few who survived were taken as exiles to Babylon, and they because servants tot he king and his sons until the kingdom of Persia came to power.

So the message of the LORD spoken through Jeremiah was fulfilled. The land finally enjoyed its Sabbath rest, lying desolate until the seventy years were fulfilled, just as the prophet had said.




The 69 Weeks
